## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

### **Course: Engineering**

#### **1. What is Eligibility Criteria?**

**Answer: First Year B.Tech**

(1) Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate:

- The Candidate should be an Indian National;
- Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or Technical or Vocational subjects and obtained at least 50 % marks (at least 45% marks, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) in the above subjects taken together;

**Or**

- Passed Diploma in Engineering and Technology and obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45 % marks, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only);

**Or**

- Passed B.Sc. Degree from a Recognized University as defined by UGC and obtained at least 50 % marks (at least 45 % marks, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only);
- Obtained score in CET conducted by the Competent Authority.

2. All India Candidature Candidates, Jammu and Kashmir Migrant Candidature Candidates:

All above criterion i, ii, iii, iv and obtained score in CET or JEE Main Paper I.

#### **Direct Second Year**

For Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate and All India Candidature Candidates:

- The Candidate should be an Indian National;
- Passed Diploma Course in Engineering and Technology with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) in appropriate branch of Engineering and Technology from an All

India Council for Technical Education or Central or State Government approved Institution or its equivalent;

**Or**

Passed B.Sc. Degree from a University Grants Commission (UGC) or Association of Indian Universities recognized University with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) and passed HSC with Mathematics as a subject Provided that students belonging to this category shall clear the subjects of Engineering Graphics/ Engineering Drawing and Engineering Mechanics of the first year Engineering Program along with second year subjects.

### **Eligibility Criteria for Linguistic Minority Quota admission**

Candidates having mother tongue 'Hindi' and domicile of Maharashtra State are eligible. For Minority Quota Seats following documents are mandatory (in addition to above):

- (a) Domicile certificate of candidate indicating that he/she is domiciled in the State of Maharashtra by birth or permanent residence.
- (b) An Affidavit (original) in the prescribed format
- (c) Proforma - M1 (Certificate from Head Master / Principal of Junior College). This is latest additional requirement by the DTE, Mumbai.

### **Eligibility Criteria for M.Tech**

- For Maharashtra Candidature Candidates and All India Candidature Candidates:
  - i. The Candidate should be an Indian National;
  - ii. Passed Bachelor Degree in the relevant field of Engineering and Technology from All India Council for Technical Education or Central or State Government approved institutions or equivalent, with at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and persons with disability belonging to Maharashtra State only);
  - iii. Passed Bachelor Degree in the relevant course of Engineering and Technology as specified in the eligibility criteria for admission to a Post Graduate Degree course of the concerned University for which admission is being sought;
  - iv. Obtained score in Graduates Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) conducted by Indian Institute of Technology
  - v. For sponsored candidates, minimum of two years of full time work experience in a registered firm/ company/ industry/ educational and/ or research institute/ any Government Department

or Government Autonomous Organization in the relevant field in which admission is being sought.
