Item No. 1 : To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting held on 28/07/2017.

TY B. Tech. (Computer , IT & MCA) course structure as well as syllabus were shown and discussed.

TY B.Tech.(Computer Engineering & IT)

In Term V,

- For Database Management system, credits for lab of Database Management system will be 1 instead of 2.
- For Software Engineering & Project Management, Lab of 2 credits is added in which students will implement Mini Project by using concepts of Software engineering.
- Tutorial is added for Web Technology , now credits for theory are 3 and 1 for tutorial.

In Term VI,

- Instead of two electives , only one elective is offered & one elective (EIE-II) is converted into core subject
- It is suggested by BOS members to revise electives of Computer & IT department .

TY B.Tech.(IT)

- In term V, Industry person should be identified to teach financial management related subjects like Engineering economics & Industrial management.

TY MCA

- Structure and Syllabus of V th Semester shown & discussed.

Item No. 4 : Review on Final year B.Tech. Syllabus.

Structure of Final year B.Tech. was discussed with BOS members.

Final Year B.Tech (Computer Engineering)

- For industry internship, continuous assessment should be 150 marks instead of 100 marks and external should be of 100 marks. College guide will be external for the examination.

Final year B. Tech (Information Technology)

- For industry internship, continuous assessment should be 100 marks and external should be of 100 marks. College guide will be external for the examination.
- In term VI, Wireless sensor networks from Ele-III should be renamed as Wireless ad hoc networks.

Item No. 5 : Review on Departmental Activities

Both the subject Experts from COEP appreciated the extra efforts taken for arranging various activities such as seminar, expert lectures, workshops & Industrial visits. They also suggested that some portion of syllabus should be taught by Industry persons.

Item No. 4 : Discussion on TY B.TECH Syllabus.

TY B.Tech (Computer Engineering)

Term 5:

- Computer Network Subject is revised with Network Architecture and Protocol to be offered by IT.
- Elective –I from term VI and Software Engineering and Project Management from term V are swapped.
- Artificial Intelligence and Expert Systems is moved to term VI with one credit added for its lab.
- The total credits for term V are finalized as 24.

Term 6:

- Language Processor name is replaced with System Programming as suggested by Dr. Vahida Attar mam and the number of credits of practical is increased from 1 to 2.
- The credits for Elective-I and Elective- II is increased by 1 and the Elective-I and Elective-II buckets are reshuffled.
- The total credits for term VI are finalized as 26.

TY B. Tech (Information Technology)

Term 5:

- **Software Engineering is renamed as Software Engineering and Project Management. It is also suggested to redesign the syllabus and shift to VI semester with 3 theory and 1 tutorial credits instead of that Elective –I is added with 4 credits.**
- **In Service Oriented Architecture one Tutorial is added, total credits for Service Oriented architecture are 4 now.**
